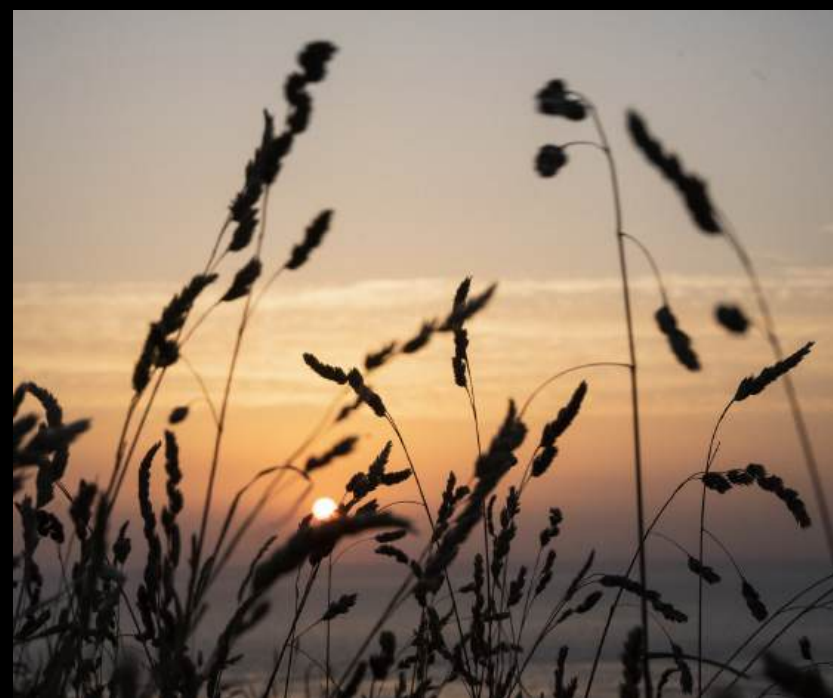

- 18 rooms with a large ballroom/ conference suite, landscaped gardens and cosy reception areas which were fully refurbished in 2014

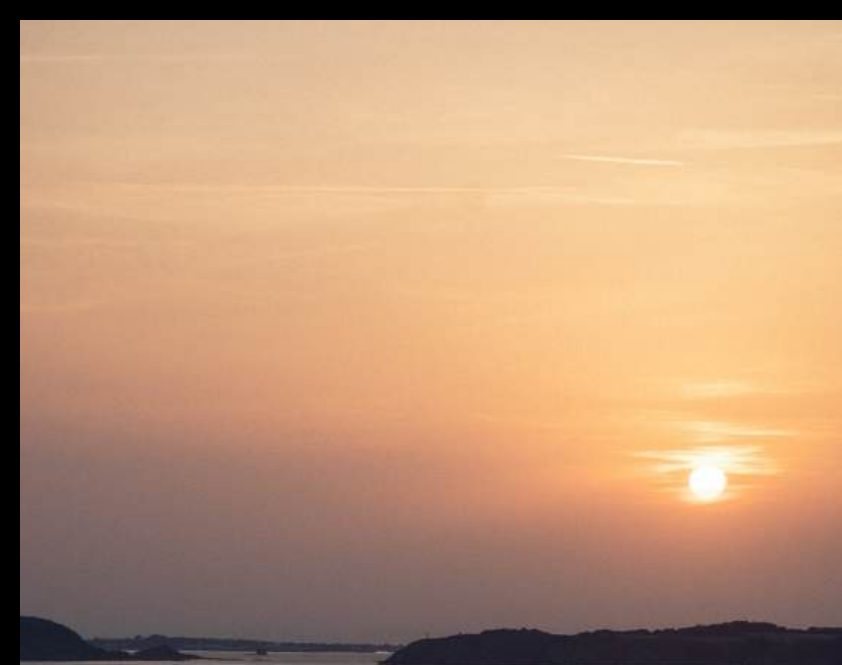


- Direct access to Sark's most popular sandy swimming beach, Dixcart Bay
